



Sisters Folk Festival Summer Camp Plan – COVID-19

During Summer 2020, Sisters Folk Festival will conduct safe and enriching music and arts camps for students aged 10-14 years. This document outlines specific measures that will be introduced to prevent the spread of COVID-19 during summer camp offerings.

Location & Site Capacity

- Camps will be held outside in grassy backyard location of the Sisters Art Works building, 204 W Adams Ave in Sisters, OR.
- Backyard area is approximately 10,500 square feet.
- Groups will be a maximum of 10 students + 1 instructor. A maximum of 2 groups will held simultaneously, and groups will not be permitted to mingle or combine.
- Six-foot physical distancing will be strictly adhered to.
- Camps will run M-F from 9am-4pm.
- A combination of 10'x20' and 10'x10' canopies with optional sides will be used for shade and rain protection.

Check-in/out

- Parents will check-in students at backyard deck area, maintaining 6-foot social distancing at all times.
- Signs will be posted to communicate necessity of physical distancing and face coverings.
- Check in/out roster will include names, contact phone numbers, and arrival/departure times.
- Students will be sent out to parents individually.

Health Screening

- Students and parents will be asked the government recommended questions for health screening each morning.
- Students who pass health screening will be required to use hand sanitizer before beginning camp activities.
- Anybody exhibiting signs of illness, or not successfully passing the health screening, will not be allowed to participate in activities.

Cleaning Policy

- Hand sanitizer and additional hand washing opportunities will be available throughout camp.
- Instruments provided by SFF will be thoroughly cleaned prior to use, and the same instrument will be used by the student throughout the week. Sharing of instruments will not be allowed.
- Art supplies will be cleaned as necessary for shared supplies, and individual supplies utilized as much as possible.
- Materials will be sanitized every day after class.

Restrooms

- Restrooms are inside the Sisters Art Works building. Each restroom is a single enclosed restroom. Only one person allowed in at a time.
- Students will be instructed to wash their hands using the bathroom sink before returning to outside activities.

Contact Tracing

- SFF will take daily attendance including check-in/checkout time and name of person who drops off/picks up.
- SFF will keep record of any staff interacting with students each day, and will primarily be limited to 3 staff members.
- SFF requires medical form on file for all participants, which will include all contact information and any medical conditions.

Camp Operations

- Camp will be conducted exclusively outside.
- A combination of 10'x20' and 10'x10' canopies with optional sides will be used for shade and rain protection.
- Six-foot physical distancing will be maintained at all times.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at multiple locations around camp.
- Students must bring their own water bottles and will be able to refill as needed.
- Students who don't choose the lunch/snack option must bring their own lunch and snacks each day.
- Staff is required to wear masks any time 6' physical distancing is not feasible.
- Students are highly encouraged to bring masks and utilize any time 6' physical distancing is not feasible.
